Rudy Pinot Noir Sta. Rita Hills

The 2014 Rudy Pinot Noir is sourced from the Sta. Rita Hills AVA located in Santa Barbara County.

The Pinot Noir goes through two sorts. First, a whole cluster and M.O.G. (materials other than grapes) sort where leaves and bad clusters are removed. The berries are then de-stemmed and dropped on to a shaker table. The grapes are sorted and poor quality berries are removed and raisins drop through the grated table top. Fermentation last for around 20 days at which point the pinot is then pressed and barreled for 12 months in French oak. The wine is split between 70% neutral and 30% new oak. This delightful Pinot Noir has a bouquet of fresh blackberries and blueberries. Fine tannins compliment an excellent acidity and rich red fruits.
